policy on unattended adults

Parents think of children's museums as "safe havens," and safeguarding our guests' well-being is the Museum's first responsibility. The San Luis Obispo Children's Museum offers three floors of exhibits and an outdoor play yard. Museum staff members are located on each floor to assist guests during their visit.

We are happy to provide a staff escorted tour of the Museum to adult guests without children at no charge. If a staff person is unavailable to provide a tour because of high guest volume or because the Museum is short staffed, adults visiting the Museum without children can contact the Museum to schedule a tour. We are happy to schedule tours in advance. The Museum offers free tours each week on Wednesday at 1:00pm.

This situation most often occurs for teachers scouting the Museum for a class field trip, parents investigating the Museum as a location for their child's birthday party, media interested in writing/filming a story about the Museum, or as a professional courtesy to Museum staff visiting from other Museums, et. al.
